Monitoring & Evaluation Consider how you will monitor the impacts of your projects and evaluate their success.	Before and after photos. Pupil feedback. Reduction in plastic/energy useage.

Eco-Schools Topic	Energy
Aim	Raise awareness of what our carbon footprint is and how we can reduce it.
Action(s)	<p>Year 5 to continue to be our energy monitors.</p> <p>During STEM week, focus on how we can reduce our carbon footprint and learn about renewable energy. Also link to our annual Walk to School Week.</p> <p>Look into Count your Carbon and Switch Off Now initiatives.</p> <p>Look into whether an electric charging point can be installed in the school car park.</p> <p>Push for the grant to go through to fix rooves, which in turn will improve insulation.</p> <p>Consider whether we need to put energy saving posters up and whether we should republish our energy tips on a newsletter/school newspaper.</p>
Informing & Involving	Display board, eco reps to feedback to class, school website, assemblies, school newspaper and newsletter.
Monitoring & Evaluation	<p>Energy graphs (both the ones produced by our energy monitors but also the ones downloaded from West Mercia Energy).</p> <p>Pupil feedback.</p>

Topic 3

Eco-Schools Topic	Healthy Living
Aim	Promote healthy living both within and outside school
Action(s)	<p>Raise the profile of our healthy school reps, who should continue to be our hygiene monitors.</p> <p>Look into whether we can introduce Meat Free Mondays and discuss how we can be healthier and more eco friendly with the canteen staff.</p> <p>Encourage teachers to teach more outside.</p> <p>Can we increase the children's physical activity within school?</p> <p>Continue to put healthy recipes in the school newspaper.</p> <p>Award children who eat all their lunch.</p> <p>Put reminders in the newsletter and school newspaper that children should be eating healthy snacks only at break time, supplying ideas as to what these could be.</p>
Informing & Involving	<p>Healthy School reps will write to the Coombs Catering Partnership.</p> <p>Speak to teacher and particularly the PE leaders and headteacher about physical activity.</p> <p>Assemblies, School website, newsletters and the school newspaper.</p>
Monitoring & Evaluation	<p>Teacher/pupil feedback</p> <p>Observation of break time snacks</p> <p>Changes brought about in the canteen</p>
